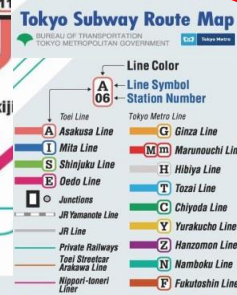
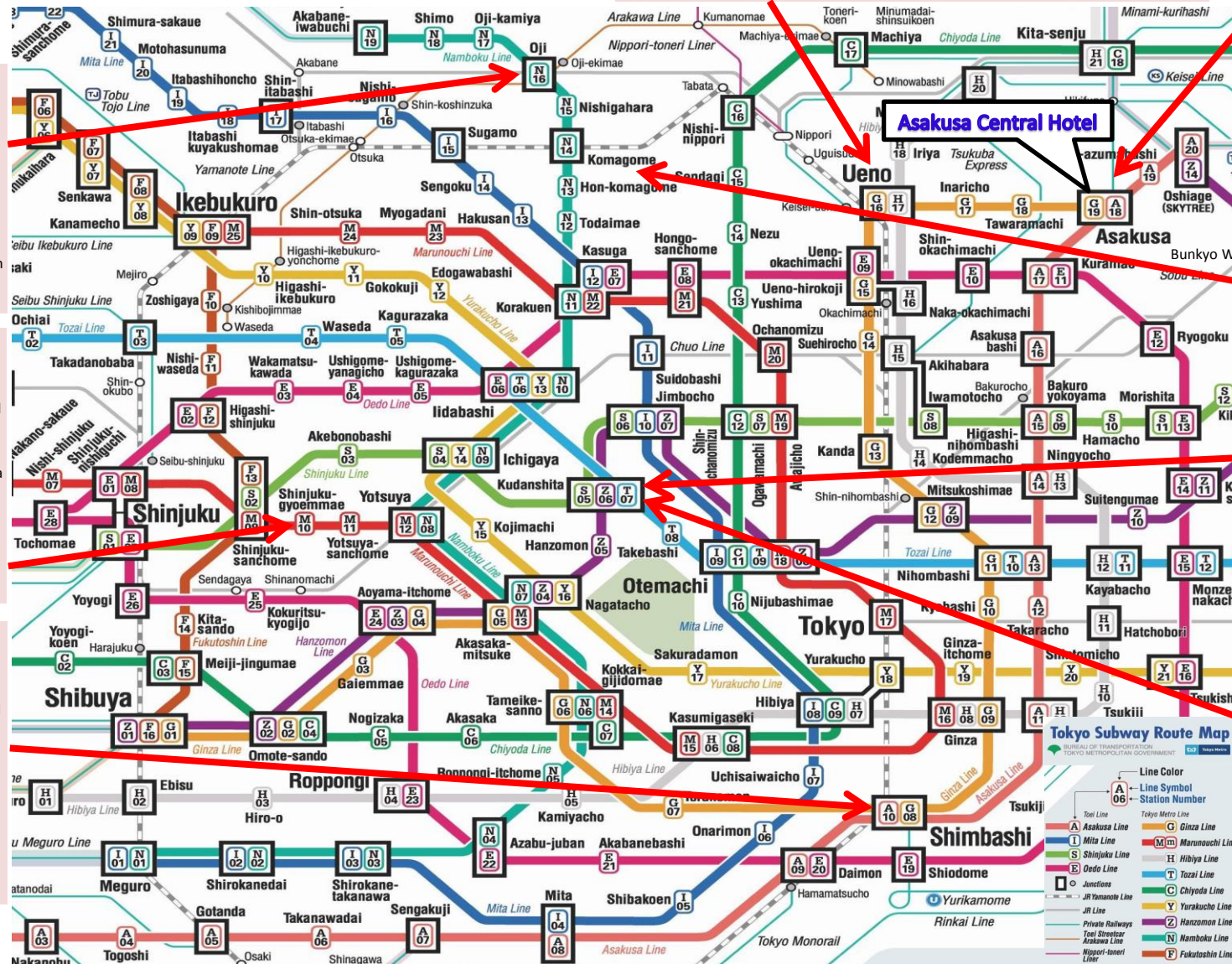

Summary The total area of about 530,000 square meters park, This is the attractions of cherry blossoms. Light-up 17:30 to 20:00 during the Festival.

Type Yoshino cherry tree, Ooshimazakura etc About 1000 pieces

Events Chiyoda SAKURA Festival (29th March~8th April)

Summary Leading Hanami attractions in the city center in one of the Edo Castle in the moat. Recommend cherry seen from houseboat. Light-up to 22:00



② Sumida Park

Type Yoshino cherry tree, Weeping cherry, etc About 1000 pieces

Events Bokutei SAKURA Festival (20th March~8th April)

Summary Sumida Park, about 1km from Azumabashi to Sakurabashi, cherry trees will continue along both banks of the Sumida River. Recommend cherry seen from houseboat. Light-up to 21:30 during Flowering.

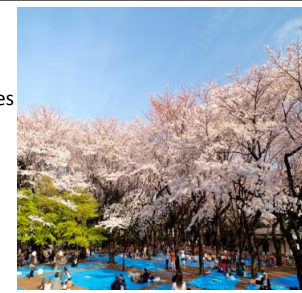


⑥ Asukayama Park

Type Yoshino cherry tree, Weeping Yae Beni, etc About 650 pieces

Events SAKURA Festival (1st April~2nd April), Park museum

Summary Specified in Japan's first park along with the Ueno Park, etc in 1873. Developed as part of the 8th Shogun Yoshimune reform of Kyoho, it is known as a park that made the construction. Also, the park museum famous.



③ Rikugien Gardens

Type Yoshino cherry tree, Weeping cherry, etc About 40 pieces

Events Light up the daimyo garden (21th March~5th April)

Summary About 15 m of height and the width also come to about 20 m for a symbol in Rikugi-en garden "weeping cherry". The state which is hung from its stately shape of branch so that it thrust at a pale pink flower at the place is itself magnificently. The form that it shine beautifully in sunlight in spring and appear in a night sky. Those are impression enough. The open hour will be extension until 21:00 during a period.
